BAN ON DRIVING OF VEHICLES IN PUBLIC PLACES BY MINORS GRADES VI-XII

Dear Parents,

As per the Uttar Pradesh government order CAMP/40601-40697/2023-24, dated 02 January 2024, individuals under the age of 18 are strictly prohibited from driving two-wheelers and four-wheelers. The Department of Transportation has noted that some school students drive scooters or other vehicles recklessly, posing serious risks to themselves and others.

In light of this, a complete ban has been imposed on minors driving vehicles in public areas. The following regulations are now in effect:

- Driving a vehicle by a minor will result in penalties for the vehicle owner. Under this provision, the vehicle owner can face up to 3 years of imprisonment and a fine of ₹25,000.
- If parents allow children to drive scooty or car, they will be punished with three years of imprisonment and a fine of ₹25,000.
- Section 5 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 stipulates that if someone does not have a valid license, the owner of the vehicle will not allow the person to drive the vehicle nor will grant permission for it. In such cases, the registration of the vehicle used in the commission of the offence will be cancelled for one year.

In compliance with these government orders, no student is allowed to commute to school on a self-driven two-wheeler or four-wheeler. Strict action will be taken against any violations. The school will not be responsible for any theft or accidents involving vehicles parked outside the school campus.

We urge all parents to cooperate in ensuring the safety of our children.
